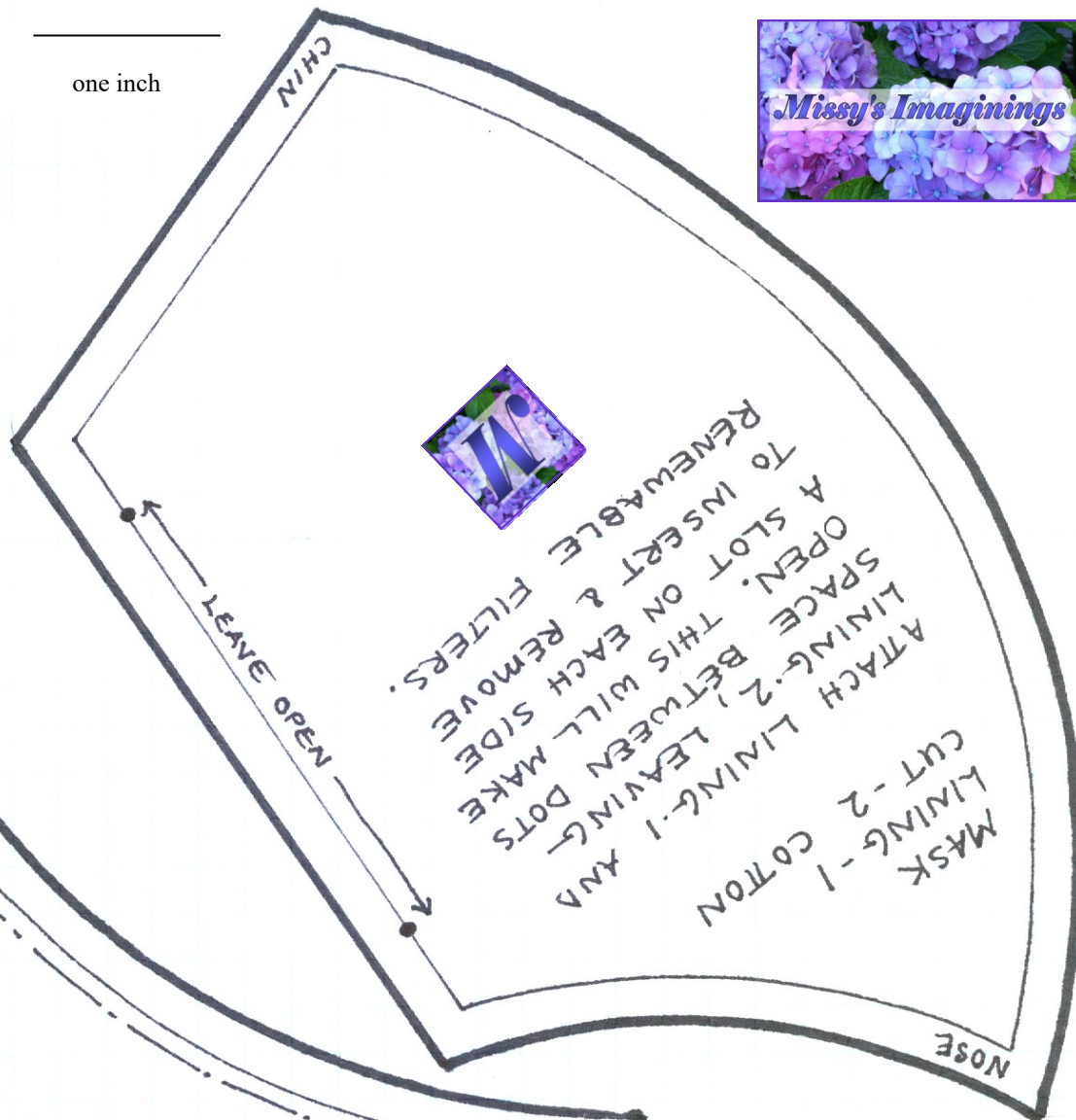


Hello, All! Here is the pattern I adjusted. We needed a size that was between a "L" and "XL" size. I wanted a little more coverage below the chin that would not pull up when speaking. I also narrowed the ends by the ears to give a smoother fit with less gap at the bottom. The other adjustment I made was to have slots on the inside for inserting renewable filters throughout a wear period. For filters, use a bonded, non-woven fabric such as interfacing.

CUT-2 1/8" ELASTIC BANDS, EACH
MEASURING 6 1/2" LONG

* CUT 2 EXTRA FILTER PIECES AT
THE BROKEN LINE. SEW THESE
TOGETHER AT FACE FRONT & INSERT
INTO FINISHED MASK THROUGH
LINING OPENINGS. THIS FILTER
PIECE CAN BE
REPLACED BETWEEN
WEARS.
